The electrical schematic is nearly finished, and we have started to build the control panels for the driver cockpit. We plan to have the car up and running within the next three weeks; the whole team is extremely excited!



For TARS, we cut out holes in the array platform for our canopy and the brake and signal lights. Next, we plan to install the swing arm and motor. Although CASE is our cur-

rent priority, we are working hard to have this car finished in the near future as well.
